# Dear Parents & Community

#### Greetings.

So term two has commenced and we are operating both in-house and online. As you would have read in my correspondence on Monday, we will be monitoring what 'on line provision' of learning' looks like as the weeks go by. As of today, we have 73% of our mainstream students at school and when we include our IELP students the overall attendance stands at 70%. I expect as we continue to hear more positive news about the decreasing presence of the Covid virus in our general community, we will see an increase in our student numbers across both programs. I would add however, that we understand and respect that families hold a range of viewpoints about this virus and until we are notified otherwise, we will endeavour to offer opportunities for home learning as well as face to face. Of course with fuller classes we can no longer combine year levels so there will be a significant lessening of teacher online presence but work will be made available. Your children's teachers will make contact with you regarding home learning.

Thank you to everyone regarding social distancing at school. Whilst we have been informed to run our classes without the need to socially distance, the expectation is that we maintain the distancing regulations with adults.
