Dear parents and community members,

After many weeks of disrupted learning we are pleased to say that we are nearly back to full numbers at Bellevue. I do need to commend every single student at our school for their maturity and kindness throughout this period. We have had quite a variety of new staff and last minute timetable changes to juggle and the children have made this flow seamlessly. We are very proud to hear relief teachers finish their day and report that the class was one of the best they have ever had! So well done!

Marie-Louise is currently on some well deserved Long Service Leave and we trust that she is travelling safely. Steve Mallee is also taking leave for the final week of term and we wish him well.

Two weeks ago most of our year 5 students took part in the NAPLAN online practice test. The practice helps to test that the platform will work when large groups of students log on to the system. It is not a scored test but it does give the students some valuable practice for the actual test. While it does not test everything, NAPLAN is one way that we can collect student data about their performance against a standard measure. Teachers use this data as well as many other means to inform them of the needs of the students in their classes and to make decisions about the level of teaching required at both class and individual level.

Over the last 4 weeks we have had Athletics Coaches provided through a sporting schools grant. They have expertly taught the children long jump, discus, shot put and sprinting skills as well as some additional training for our district athletics and cross country runners. We have had three students represent our school at the district swimming day and they all enjoyed the competitive atmosphere and opportunity to try out their skills against other schools.
