Over the past 2.5 years we have had to embrace a new mindset and develop many and varied skillsets with regards to how we deal with the impact of the pandemic on a day to day basis. As a school, we will endeavour to do our best to provide consistent learning opportunities but we do not know what will take place in terms of staffing from day to day. Thank you for supporting us thus far and we hope that this next wave will sweep gently over us all.

This term will be no doubt be as busy as our previous terms. I am looking forward to Book Week, the Robo Cup competition and Sports Day. Coaching clinics will continue over the term as will some music incursions.

On Monday this week our staff worked on the second goal of our Site Improvement Plan. This goal is to increase the number of students in the high bands of Maths outcomes. We looked at how we could implement rich authentic tasks that engage all learners. We explored the importance of visualization and manipulatives in terms of students developing a deep understanding of mathematical concepts. For example are you aware that finger counting is a very valid strategy for any person who is grappling with a maths problem?

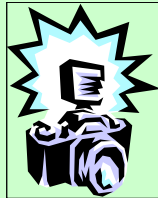

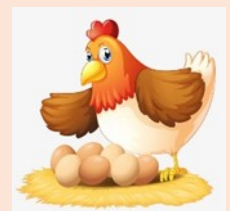
To all the families who helped out over the July School holidays.

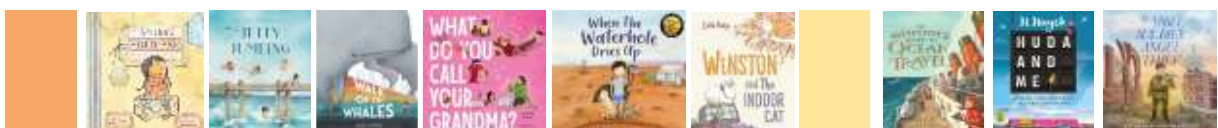
