

French - Reception and Year 1 Term 4

This term in French, we will learn the names of fruits that grow in New Caledonia. Then practise making sentences about how to plant these fruits using different body parts. We will also learn basic greetings and numbers, which will help us to buy fruit at a market.

We're also looking forward to discovering how Halloween and Christmas are celebrated in France compared to Australia. It's a great way to learn about different cultures. And, at the end of the year, we'll perform the beautiful French Christmas song 'Vive le Vent' during our concert. It's going to be a lot of fun!





Key questions to investigate

- What fruit grows in New Caledonia?
- How do we write a sentence in French?
- What language do we use when shopping at the market?
- What is similar and different about how Christmas is celebrated in France to Australia?

Cultures of Thinking protocols

Students will:

- use 'See, Think, Connect' to compare Christmas in France to Australia. How are they similar or different?
- use 'Headlines' to capture the main messages in French songs.

Reception students will:

- **interact** through using play and imagination
- mimic French pronunciation
- copy labels to create French texts with support
- identify that French and English look and sound different
- recognise that there are languages and cultures as well as their own, and that aspects of language and culture contribute to their own and others' cultural identity.

Year 1 students will:

- use cues to respond to questions and instructions, and use simple formulaic language
- **locate** and **convey** key items of information in texts using non-verbal, visual and contextual cues to help make meaning
- use modelled language to create texts
- imitate the sounds and rhythms of French
- give examples of similarities and differences between some features of French and English
- **understand** that language is connected with culture and notice how this is reflected in their own language(s) and culture(s).
