

Hot weather/Sun Safety Reminder:

Children must wear a sun safe hat when outside, on excursions children must wear maroon school hat. Children need to wear sun safe clothing with their shoulders covered, no singlet tops. Children should arrive to OSHC with sunscreen on and parents/caregivers to tick box on sign in sheet. Children are to wear appropriate footwear, thongs are not to be worn on excursions or when playing outside. Children who are wearing thongs should pack enclosed shoes in their bag.

Excursion Safety

The safety of the children is our number one priority when going on excursions. We have strict procedures we follow at all times. Some things we are currently implementing to ensure safety are private bus transport, to ensure all children and educators remain together. Children and educator wear Fluro vests, maroon school hats and wrist bands with our contact information on every excursion. Travel route maps are available for parents/caregivers to view.
