### **Hot weather/Sun Safety Reminder:**

Some things we are currently implementing to ensure safety are private bus transport, to ensure all children and educators remain together. Children and educator wear Fluro vests, maroon school hats and wrist bands with our contact information on every excursion. Travel route maps are available for parents/caregivers to view.
