School Fees 2024

After the Governing Council meeting dated 30th October 2023, all our families were invited to vote in a poll to make the 2024 Materials Services Charge legally recoverable. This process was done online. Thank you to the many families/caregivers who returned their votes. The result was overwhelmingly (81%) in favour of making our Materials & Services charge of \$395 for 2024 fully legally recoverable.

Invoices for 2024 will be issued early next year and payment of school fees should be made before the end of Term 1. If you would like to enter a payment plan for the fees please contact the Finance Office and they will be able to assist you with this.

School Card assistance is available to parents who meet the financial criteria. Applications will be processed by the Department for Education on the completion of the School Card form. Application forms are available at the school or online at www.sa.gov.au and must be completed every year. If you require assistance in completing a school card application please contact the Finance office.

A reminder that from 2024 we will no longer be charging an annual events levy. Families will receive an invoice for each excursion on a pay as you go basis. (See the last newsletter.)

We look forward to seeing it at the Blackwood Christmas Tree Festival.






Park Rangers News







